

**Transportation Action Group: Update on Goals**  
**August 8, 2008**

**Short Term Goals:**

**Bike rack.** We're still figuring out the ownership of the planting strip where we want to put the bike rack- should know by next week and then will schedule an install date - I'll let you all know when it is. We have an offer of help from Jack Williams, maintenance person at the Horseshoe club (through Kristi Servati and Jolene Miley). Also Jean B. and her husband might be able to help. Any other expertise is welcome too. I'll be in touch. Crosswalk striping: Robin Williamson and Tammy have spoken to City staff (Larry Werner) who says it will be done!

**Pedestrian flags.** Jean B. has volunteered to head this up - thanks Jean! Anyone who wants to help, contact her. We might especially be looking for sponsors for the flags.

**Long Term Goal:**

"Curry Street Promenade Enhancement Project"

Things are moving along fast here too. In its meeting next week RTC/CAMPO is going to be talking about potential projects to apply for transportation enhancements funding for (Transportation Enhancements is a special funding source for bike, pedestrian, landscaping, and other transportation-related projects, from the feds passed through the state - biannual application process).

While we have not yet had the chance to present anything to the Board of Supervisors, we can't miss this opportunity to get on the city's list of potential projects because it won't come around again for another two years. So I've been in touch with Robin Williamson explaining the potential project to her. She's agreed to run it by the supervisors - Shelly Aldean and Richard Staub - who are on the RTC/CAMPO board. I'm waiting to hear back from her about the results of this.

The RTC/CAMPO meeting is next Wednesday, August 13. If Robin succeeds in getting the project on the table for possible inclusion in the City's list of enhancements projects, it would probably be good to have someone from our action group at the meeting to speak in favor of it.
